CONDITIONS:

- Competition to be run in accordance with Australian Farriers' and Blacksmiths' Association Competition Rules and By-Laws
- Proof of payment must accompany entry. An entry that isn't accompanied by a cheque or a copy/screenshot of bank transfer will be considered invalid and will not be processed.
- Competitors must be members of PFBAQ or AFBA affiliated member.
- **Safety glasses** must be worn by **all competitors** and **horse holders** while in competition arena. It is the competitor's responsibility to bring safety glasses to the competition.
- Competitors are to organize their own horse holders.

Event 1: Ross Chicken Open Shoeing/Forging

1. Shoe 1 Foot with a $\frac{3}{4}$ Fullered, hammer drawn toe clip, nails to suit.
2. Make a $\frac{3}{4}$ Fullered straight bar shoe, hammer finished, out of 25mm x 8mm flat bar, 140mm wide x 145mm long. Nail MX50. Fireman allowed.

Time: 60 minutes

Event 2: Apprentice Shoeing/Forging

1. Shoe 1 foot with packet shoe provided.
2. Make a specimen shoe as per blue print. Plain stamped front toe clipped shoe out of 20x10 flat bar, 130mm wide 135mm long. Nail E4 Slim. Fireman allowed. (Fireman allowed to go to foot to advise on trimming, shoe fit etc. but cannot touch the foot).

Time: 60 minutes

Event 3: Master and Apprentice Class

Master and Apprentice can enter as a team or Apprentices can enter individually and will be paired up at random with a qualified farrier competing. Drawn teams will be notified 1 week prior to contest. Shoe 1 foot with a $\frac{3}{4}$ Fullered, toe clipped shoe and make a specimen shoe provided on the day.

Time: 60 minutes

Event 4: Open Judges Choice

30 minutes to make a shoe to judge's specimen shown on the day.

Event 5: Apprentice Judges Choice

30 minutes to make a shoe to judge's specimen shown on the day.

Event 6: Mystery Bag

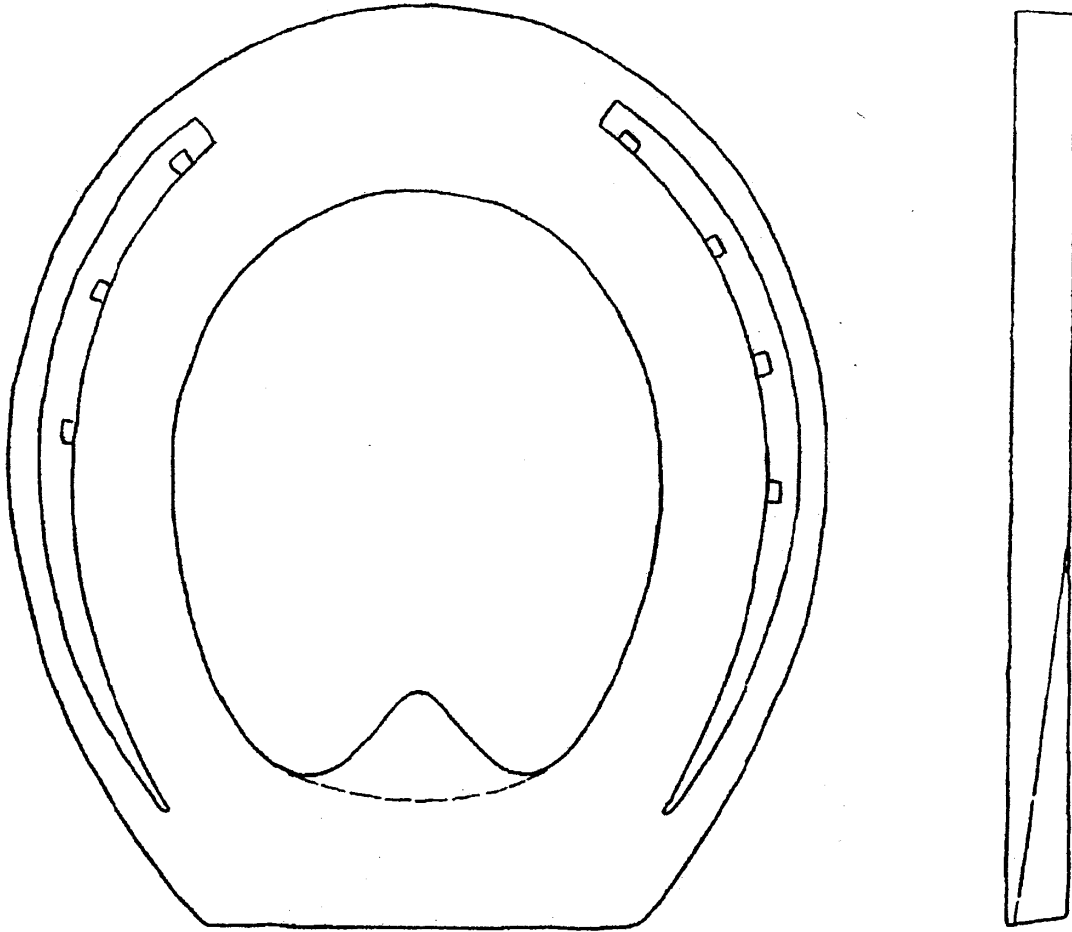
Three pieces of steel drawn on the day. Competitor to create item of choice using the pieces of steel drawn.

Criteria: Forging –10, Welding—10, Degree of Content – 10, Appeal – 10, Finish – 10.

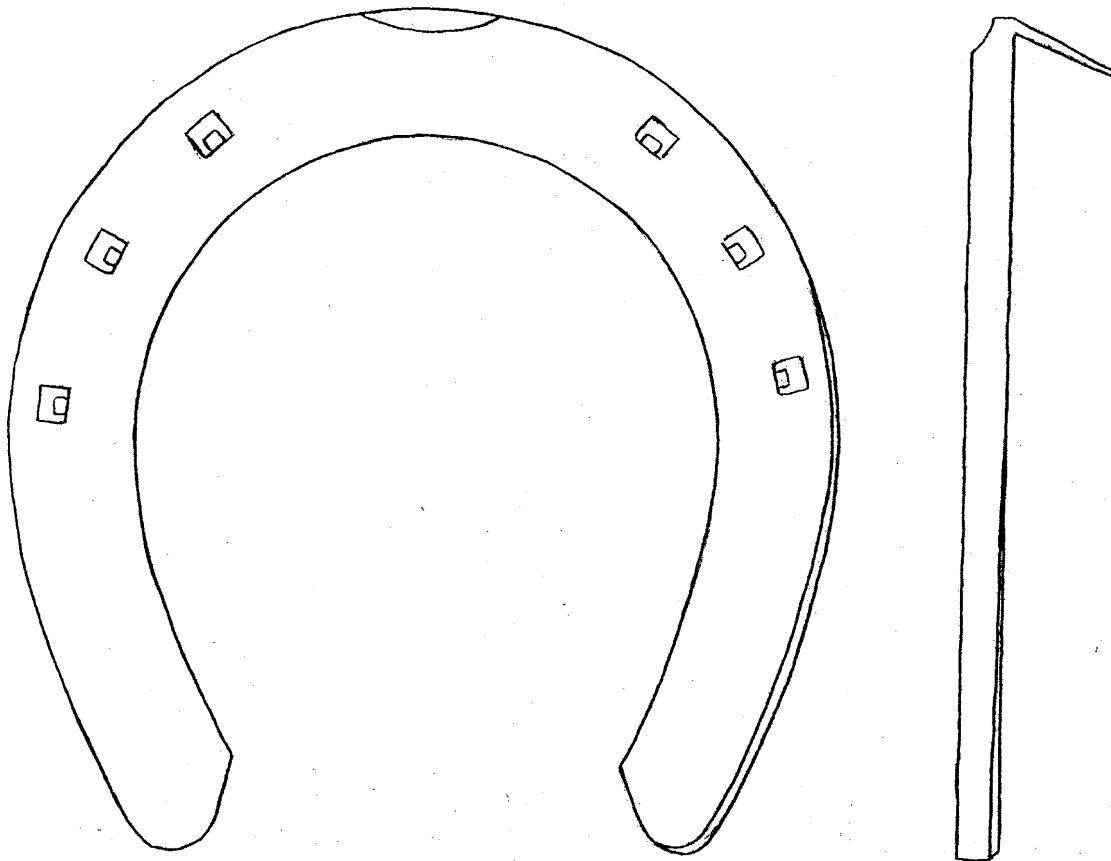
